



RECORDS

In 2008 Joey Votto hit 23 of his 24 home runs as a first baseman, a new club record for homers by a rookie at that position. He broke the mark held by Ted Kluszewski, who had 12 HR as a first baseman in 1948. Votto also became the first player in franchise history to produce at least 20 homers and 30 doubles in his rookie season.

The Reds' Biggest Inning Ever, August 3, 1989 vs Houston, 1st Inning

Jim Clancy pitching for the Astros. Mariano Duncan led off with a walk, then stole second with Luis Quinones batting. Quinones singled to the mound, Duncan moved to third base. Eric Davis singled to center scoring Duncan, advancing Quinones to second base (1-0). Ken Griffey hit a 3-run homer to right-center (4-0). Rolando Roomes singled to short. Todd Benzinger singled to right, advancing Roomes to third base. Jeff Reed singled to right, scoring Roomes and advancing Benzinger to second base (5-0).

New Pitcher: Bob Forsch. Ron Oester doubled to right, scoring Benzinger and advancing Reed to third base (6-0). Tom Browning grounded out to first, runners held. With Duncan batting, wild pitch scored Reed, Oester to third base (7-0). Duncan doubled to right, scoring Oester (8-0). Quinones singled to left, advancing Duncan to third base. Davis singled to center, scoring Duncan and advancing Quinones to second base (9-0). Griffey singled to center, scoring Quinones, and advancing Davis to third base (10-0). Roomes singled to third, loading the bases. Benzinger cleared the bases with a double (13-0). Reed singled to center, advancing Benzinger to third base. Oester singled to right, scoring Benzinger, and advancing Reed to second base (14-0). Browning singled to left, loading the bases. Duncan flied to left. Quinones flied to right. (14 Runs, 16 Hits, 0 Errors, 3 LOB).

The Reds set or tied four Major League records. **Records Set:** Most hits in an inning since 1900 (16); most singles in an inning (12) and most players with 2 or more hits in an inning (7). **Records Tied:** Most players with 3 or more hits in a game since 1900 (7).

**September 16, 1988:
One Perfect Night**

On September 16, 1988, lefthander Tom Browning tossed the only perfect game in Cincinnati Reds history when he retired all 27 batters faced in a 1-0 victory over the Los Angeles Dodgers.

It was only the 14th perfect game of 9.0 innings or more in Major League history, just the third in modern National League history and the first no-hitter by a Reds pitcher since Tom Seaver blanked the Cardinals, 4-0, on June 16, 1978.

Browning's perfect game capped off an incredible season in which he posted an 18-5 record, including a 16-2 mark after June 6.
